

# Terms and Regulations of Juvilo Journal Portal

## §1. General Provisions

1. Juvilo Journal is an educational and popular-science portal. It is a project created by young people for young people.
2. Juvilo Journal serves as a platform for young people to publish their articles, scientific papers, research papers, popular-science and journalistic texts, podcasts, short films and feature films on scientific topics related to their passions and interests.
3. Juvilo Journal is managed by an independent youth editorial team.
4. The goal of the portal is to promote science, support the development of young authors, and create a space for publishing educational and popular-science content.

## §2. Rules of Using the Portal

1. The portal is open to anyone interested in science, scientific writing, and popular-science content.
2. Users and authors are required to show respect toward other users of the portal.
3. The portal aims to create a safe space for learning, publishing, and exchanging ideas.
4. Publishing offensive, vulgar, degrading, aggressive content, or content inciting violence or hatred is prohibited.
5. The portal supports a culture of substantive and civil discussion based on arguments and mutual respect.
6. Discriminatory content or content violating the dignity of others is not permitted.
7. Publishing spam, provocative content, or content intentionally disrupting the community is prohibited.
8. The editorial team may remove content that violates the portal's rules.
9. Using the portal in a manner that violates applicable law is prohibited.
10. Publishing illegal content, content infringing copyright, violating personal rights, containing threats, promoting violence, or activities contrary to law is not permitted.
11. Impersonating other individuals or publishing content that misleads users about authorship is prohibited.
12. Actions that may disrupt the operation of the portal or compromise the security of its users are prohibited.

## §3. Rules for Publishing Materials

1. Texts are submitted in accordance with the current submission guidelines available on the portal (under the 'Our Team' → 'Join Us' tab).

2. Authors may be individuals interested in scientific, popular-science, journalistic, or educational activities.
3. The portal supports publications created by young authors and students interested in science, culture, and journalism.
4. Published materials should be relevant to the portal's subject matter, constitute the author's own work, be based on reliable information, and maintain a respectful tone. When using sources, the author should cite them.
5. If artificial intelligence tools were used in creating the text, the author must inform the editorial team.
6. The portal does not publish texts generated entirely or partially by artificial intelligence tools.
7. Publishing the following materials is prohibited:
  - Content violating the law
  - Content containing plagiarism
  - Content infringing copyright
  - Offensive or discriminatory content
  - Hate speech
  - Content promoting violence
  - Spam or advertisements
  - Content inconsistent with the nature of the portal
8. Every material submitted for publication is mandatorily reviewed by the editorial team, which makes the decision regarding its publication.
9. The editorial team reserves the right to refuse publication of material without providing a reason.

#### **§4. Author's Declarations**

1. The author retains full economic and moral copyright to the submitted text. Publication on the portal does not constitute a transfer of copyright to the editorial team.
2. The author grants the portal a non-exclusive, royalty-free license to publish the text on the Juvilo Journal website and present it within the portal's activities.
3. The author has the right to publish their works elsewhere, at any time, and may request removal of their work from Juvilo Journal for use in other publications.
4. The author declares that:
  - They are the sole creator of the submitted text or hold full rights to use it
  - The text does not infringe the copyright of third parties
  - The text does not violate the personal rights of others or applicable law
5. When using additional materials (especially graphics, photos, charts, or quotations), the author undertakes to:
  - Hold appropriate rights to them or use them in accordance with applicable licenses

- Indicate their source
- Bear responsibility for their legality

6. If artificial intelligence (AI) tools were used in creating the text, the author is required to inform the editorial team. The editorial team may establish additional rules regarding the permissible scope of AI use.

7. The editorial team bears no responsibility for the content of published materials, particularly their compliance with the law and factual accuracy. The author bears full responsibility in this regard.

## **§5. Copyright and License**

1. The author retains economic and moral copyright to the publication.

2. By submitting material for publication, the author grants the portal a non-exclusive, royalty-free license to:

- Publish the material on the portal's website
- Store the material in the portal's archive
- Present the material in media associated with the portal's activities

3. The aforementioned license does not restrict the author's right to publish the material elsewhere.

4. Upon the author's request to remove their work from the portal and social media, the portal is obligated to fulfill the request within 15 days of the author's submission.

5. Copying, distributing, or using published materials without the author's consent is prohibited, except in cases permitted by applicable law.

6. When quoting materials published on the portal, the author and source of publication must be credited.

## **§6. Moderation and Editorial Rights**

1. The editorial team reserves the right to evaluate materials submitted for publication.

2. The editorial team may refuse publication of material, particularly when:

- It is inconsistent with the portal's subject matter
- It violates the regulations or applicable law
- It contains offensive, unreliable, or misleading content
- It infringes copyright or personal rights of third parties
- It does not include a bibliography
- It contains graphics, tables, charts, quotations, etc. that are not the author's own

3. The editorial team bears no responsibility for content published by the author; the author is fully responsible for their own work. The portal acts as an intermediary in publishing works.

4. The editorial team does not make any changes or corrections to the author's work, except in situations required by law or portal security. If changes are made, the editorial team is obligated to inform the author.

5. In the event of a report of copyright infringement, violation of personal rights, or other legal violations, the editorial team may:

- Temporarily hide the material
- Request clarification from the author
- Remove the material from the portal

6. Editorial decisions regarding publication and moderation of materials are aimed at maintaining safety.

## **§7. Rules for Comments and User Activity**

1. The portal allows users to publish comments and other forms of activity related to the portal's operation.

2. Users are required to maintain respectful communication and show respect toward other users of the portal.

3. Publishing the following content is prohibited:

- Offensive, vulgar, or aggressive content
- Discriminatory content or content inciting hatred
- Content infringing copyright or personal rights of others
- Spam, advertisements, or promotional content
- Content contrary to applicable law
- Content that may endanger the safety of users or the portal's operation

4. Impersonating other individuals and publishing false information about one's identity or authorship of materials is prohibited.

5. The editorial team may remove comments and other content that violates the regulations, or restrict the activity of users who violate the portal's rules.

6. The portal has an educational and youth-oriented character; therefore, particular emphasis is placed on safety and a culture of communication.

## **§8. Liability**

1. The author bears responsibility for the content of submitted and published materials, particularly their compliance with the law, accuracy, and respect for copyright and personal rights of third parties.

2. Views and opinions expressed by authors in published materials represent their own position and do not necessarily reflect the position of the editorial team or the portal.

3. The portal makes efforts to ensure that published content is consistent with the educational nature of the service, but bears no responsibility for the consequences of using information contained in materials published by authors.

4. The portal bears no responsibility for:

- Temporary interruptions in the service's operation

- Technical problems beyond the editorial team's control
  - Data loss resulting from technical failures or the actions of third parties
5. The editorial team takes actions to ensure the safety and proper operation of the portal, but does not guarantee uninterrupted and completely error-free operation of the service.
  6. The portal promotes reliability, responsibility, and a culture of scientific debate.

## **§9. Privacy and Personal Data Protection**

1. Detailed rules for the processing of personal data are set out in the Privacy Policy.

## **§10. Reporting Copyright Infringements**

1. Persons who believe that materials published on the portal infringe their copyright, personal rights, or applicable law may report such infringements by email to the editorial team:  
juvilo.journal@gmail.com

2. The report should include:

- Name and surname or the name of the reporting person
- Description of the reported infringement
- Link to the material in question
- Indication of which rights were violated

3. The portal accepts reports regarding, in particular:

- Plagiarism
- Copyright infringement
- Unlawful use of graphics, photos, or other materials
- Publication of content contrary to law
- Violation of personal rights or user safety

4. After receiving a report, the editorial team may:

- Contact the author of the material
- Temporarily hide the material
- Request additional clarification
- Remove the material from the portal if the infringement is confirmed

5. The editorial team makes every effort to process reports as quickly and thoroughly as possible.

6. Intentionally submitting false reports or abusing the infringement reporting procedure is prohibited.

## **§11. Communication and Social Media Activity Guidelines**

1. The portal maintains profiles on social media for the purpose of publishing materials, promoting the portal's activities, and communicating with authors and users.

2. Publication of a material on the portal may involve its promotion on social media managed by the editorial team, in particular through:

- Publishing excerpts of the text
- Publishing the title of the material
- Tagging the author
- Sharing a link to the publication

3. The editorial team undertakes to respect the authorship of published materials and tag authors where technically possible on social media platforms.

4. If an author's work is removed from the portal, the author may request removal of all published content related to their work and their person from Juvilo Journal's social media accounts.

5. If an author's work is removed from the portal, the author may request that the source of the work in social media publications be redirected to the portal where their work was placed in another publication.

## **§12. Changes to the Regulations**

1. The editorial team reserves the right to make changes to the regulations.
2. The current version of the regulations is published on the portal's website.
3. Information about changes to the regulations may be published by the editorial team.
4. Changes to the regulations take effect on the date specified by the editorial team.

## **§13. Final Provisions**

1. The regulations take effect on the date of publication on the Juvilo Journal website.

4. The portal has an educational and popular-science character.
5. In matters not regulated by the regulations, decisions are made by the editorial team in accordance with the character and principles of the portal's operation.
